- Mayonnaise




B'nai B'rith Person of the Year

In the months leading up to this current term in which you elected me to be CAS President, I have been humbled by so many people who have approached me, called, and sent text messages of support and offers of assistance for my term. Usually this showing of support was preceded by the person asking me, "Hal, are you ready?" The real question is ARE YOU READY?

All of the pieces are in place for CAS to serve you and our family of families. We have great clergy and staff who work hard every day to keep us moving forward as smoothly as possible. We have engaged committees that are made up of superhero volunteers who are spending a lot of time trying to exceed, not just meet expectations. And we have a dedicated volunteer Board of Directors trying to make sure our major decisions and the direction of the Shul are both sound and responsible...ALL WE NEED IS YOU!

It's a new world compared to the way CAS operated over 130 years ago, and considerably different today versus 2020. The pandemic changed the landscape of many faith-based organizations, ours included, and we are coming out of it blasting off like a rocket with great programming. Within the past few months, we had a fun and engaging 2nd night Passover seder with 115 people. We had a wonderful Chevra Kadisha dinner with about 80 people. B'nai B'rith held a sold-out dinner to raise money for Ukrainian Jews (a \$65,000 check was written from donations made at the event). Federation held an event here with 225 people to celebrate Israel's 75th birthday. There was also the Rockin' Ruach Friday night service led by Cantor Dorman, our new full-time Cantor, with over 100 people in attendance who were rockin' along to the Cantor and the band. If you were not at these events that took place at our Shul, then you really missed out. However, the

good news is that we have more events coming up on our calendar and ALL WE NEED IS YOU!

Additionally, if you have not been to services in a while, here are some things you should know. Our Friday night service begins at 6:00PM and we end just around 7:00PM. Saturday services start at 9:30AM and end 11:30-ish followed by what is always the best lunch in town (my favorite lunch is Maria's egg salad and tuna salad, and Rich's bagels). And weekday minyans start Monday-Friday at 6:55AM. Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday minyans finish at around 7:30AM, and Monday/Thursday being Torah days we end minyan at around 7:45AM. If you don't know much about the order of a service and would like to know why we stand, bow, sit, wrap tefillin a certain way, much of it is explained during the service. ALL WE NEED IS YOU!

I like our tag line about being "a family of families," and we are all part of the Congregation Ahavath Sholom family together. Whether you are a member because your family has been with CAS since the days of Moses (Moses Shanblum that is, one of the founders of CAS), or whatever the reason, help us out, tell us what you want. ALL WE NEED IS YOU!

If you did not pick up on the hints above, there's a lot going on...ALL WE NEED IS YOU! I look forward to seeing you around the Shul.
